"FREE" Peaceful Playgrounds Implementation Guide Available on Web

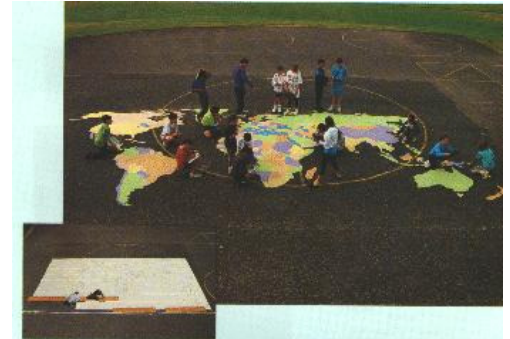
